REASON FOR THIS INFORMATION

LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING

The personal data indicated on this page are processed by Stiferite S.p.A. for the management of business relationships and the provision of the service offered.

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED AND PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING

Navigation data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data, whose transmission is implicit in the use of internet communication protocols.

This information is not collected in order to be associated with identified data subjects, but could allow users to be identified through processing and association with data held by third parties.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users connecting to the site, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) of requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response from the server (successful, error, etc..) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

This data, necessary for the use of web services, is also processed for the purpose of:

- ❖ obtaining statistical information on the use of the services (most visited pages, number of visitors per time slot or day, geographical areas of origin, etc.);
- ❖ obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its proper functioning and are deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used to establish liability in the event of hypothetical computer crimes against the site.

Data provided by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of personal data to access certain services (user registration for access to reserved areas), or to make requests for information to the addresses indicated on the website involves the subsequent acquisition of personal data included in the sender's request, which is necessary to respond to such requests.

This category of data includes the personal data of the individual, or the personal and technical data of the company to which they belong.

The data may be transferred abroad, in accordance with current legislation, to Countries belonging to the European Union or the European Economic Area and also to non-EU countries where the company may pursue its own interests. The transfer to non-EU countries, in addition to cases where this is guaranteed by Adequacy decisions of the European Commission, is carried out in such way as to provide appropriate and opportune guarantees pursuant to Articles 46 or 47 or 49 of the GDPR.

PROCESSING METHOD

Personal data are processed by automated tools for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected.

Specific security measures are in place to prevent data loss, illegal or improper use and unauthorised access.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECTS

In the cases prescribed by Articles 15 et seq. of the Regulation, the Data Subjects have the right to obtain from Stiferite S.p.A. access to their personal data and the rectification or cancellation of the same, or the limitation of the processing that concerns such data, or the right to oppose the processing. RIGHT OF CLAIM
